Professor at Technische Universität Darmstadt in Germany, where she is also Executive Director of the Institute of Language and Literature, as well as Scientific Director of the Language Centre. Her research focuses on multilingualism, multiple language learning, German as an additional foreign language, and intercultural communication. She has had visiting professorships in Canada, Sweden and Malaysia, and has served as academic consultant and as a course, programme and professorial staff evaluator in universities in Ireland, Sweden, Norway and Malaysia. She serves on the German Academic Exchange Service in Bonn, and in 2011 was elected by the council members as Deputy Chairman of the Central Agency for Schools Abroad, where she is responsible for tasks in the fields multilingualism and interdisciplinary instruction. Her publications include *Cross-Linguistic Influence in Third Language Acquisition: Psycholinguistic Perspectives*, a book she co-authored with Jasone Cenoz & Ulrike Jessner and is a free download (Multilingual Matters 2001), and *The Exploration of Multilingualism. Development of research on L3, multilingualism and multiple language acquisition* (ed. with Larissa Aronin, published in the AILA Applied Linguistics Series by Benjamins, 2009). Prof. Hufeisen represents the International Association of Multilingualism (IAM), of which she is an executive board member, on the ECSPM.
