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Intersectionality and Language Inequality

- Linguistic inequality is multidimensional (intersectional)
- Entangled with social inequality, racial bias, and cultural difference
- Movements converged around intersectionality in the 1990s
- Participatory Action Research (PAR) engages researchers with social contradictions

Challenges and Solutions in Teaching Catalan

- Partners: the Cultural Society.
- Vincles: Catalan language classes to immigrants
- Catalan vs. Spanish: Teaching a minoritized language
- Complexity of teaching Catalan to immigrants

An interplay of vulnerabilities

- Vulnerable learners
- Catalan linguistic insecurity
- Creating spaces for intercultural contact
- Navigating social, cultural, racial, and linguistic inequalities

Setting up Vincles

En aquestes sessions, els participants comparteixen aprenentatges i conversen amb un català pràctic, basat en les seves necessitats quotidianes i els seus interessos; surten al carrer, fan activitats junts i s'enxarxen amb les persones i entitats de l'entorn, en un ambient distès, igualitari i de confiança.

In these sessions, participants share learnings and converse in practical Catalan, based on their daily needs and interests; they go out, do activities together and do networking with people and organisations in the area, in a relaxed, egalitarian and trusting atmosphere.

The dialogical infrastructure: Ethnography, Training, and Evaluation

- Ethnography as a Dialogical Tool: Participant observation, interviews, focus groups
- Training Programme for Volunteers:
 - Suport a l'acompanyament.
 - Focus on accessible language sharing and sociolinguistic awareness.
- Qualitative Evaluation:
 - Open-ended questions for feedback and reflection

Ethnography

- 36 in-depth interviews with social service officers, adult education officers, volunteers teachers, local CS members, learners.
- 3 focus groups with migrant adult learners (17 people)
- 32 Participant observation sessions, mainly training sessions for volunteers and organizers as well as social gatherings and celebrations.
- 2 language sessions (substituting a volunteer).
- Observations of 7 more sessions led by volunteers with participant learners.

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The "qualitative" evaluation

- What did you enjoy most?
- What would you like to do that we haven't done?
- Do you feel you've learned Catalan?
- Have you used Catalan outside the sessions?
- Has Vincles helped you in your daily life?
- Do you want to continue next year?

Project Outcomes and Reflections

- Overcoming fear and embarrassment in speaking Catalan
- Impact on volunteers: increased sociolinguistic and social awareness
- Positive feedback and commitment to expand the project
